CITY NATURE CHALLENGE

ESF's cross-phase Sustainability team launched a fantastic initiative on Friday 25th April - the ESF City Nature Challenge. The challenge continues to run and will finish on Sunday 4 May.


This citizen science challenge has been designed to support the annual global <u>City Nature Challenge</u>. This global bioblitz at the end of April sees cities around the globe engaging in a collaboration-meets-friendly-competition to see who can document the most wildlife species in their cities. The data that we collect will support Hong Kong as it pitches itself against the likes of San Francisco, London, Cape Town, Sydney and Mumbai.

The initiative is simple to engage with- Download the iNaturalist app and photograph and document wildlife.

As a collaboration, ESF aims to document 500+ species. Glenealy students were introduced to the app last Friday. In this week along our school has already photographed and documented an amazing 70 different species. Sean and family have shared a bird called a Crested Myna. Constance and her family have shared an interesting plant called Ti with pink leaves. Scarlett and her family spent the weekend exploring many places in Hong Kong, photographing a huge variety of flowering plants, a Common Mock Viper and a South China Boar. Alric and his family have photographed a Meadow Slug, a Eurasian Tree Sparrow and some flowering plants.

We very much hope that with family support, we can actively and enthusiastically engage in this wonderful opportunity to document even more of Hong Kong's rich biodiversity.
