#### **STUDENT HEALTH**

## **MOSQUITO PREVENTION MEASURES: Chikungunya Fever (CF)**

We would like to inform you that the school has been actively maintaining mosquito prevention efforts. Our site staff have worked diligently throughout the holidays to ensure that drains and other water collection areas are regularly cleaned and sanitised.

Additionally, we have engaged Rentokil to implement mosquito control measures across the campus, including spraying and installing mosquito traps in key locations. The Food and Environmental Hygiene Department (FEHD) has also been spraying the surrounding area near Hornsey Road weekly and is in regular contact with the school to provide ongoing guidance on mosquito eradication and sanitation.

To help prevent the spread of Chikungunya Fever (CF), the Education Bureau (EDB) and the Centre for Health Protection (CHP) have issued the following recommendations:

- Students and staff returning from affected areas should apply mosquito repellent daily for at least 14 days.
- Anyone returning from an affected area who begins to feel unwell should seek professional medical advice immediately and avoid self-medicating.
- All students and staff are encouraged to apply mosquito repellent containing DEET before leaving for school each morning.

We appreciate your cooperation in helping to keep our school community safe and healthy.

#### **GATEWAY**

As we start the new academic year, we would like to request that parents update their Gateway accounts and complete all required prompts for information.

By using the 'After School Arrangements' field, you may keep us informed of the children's details of how they will go home every day. This will be valuable in keeping your children safe as the information will be visible to members of staff who may refer to it.

For students of Years 5 & 6, parents may give their permission on Gateway to allow them to leave school unaccompanied. Please access the 'After School Arrangements' tab and select the option of 'Walk Home Alone' for your child. We will issue them a Walker's Pass which must be shown to the staff on duty at dismissal time to allow them to leave the school site alone. This does not allow them to take other siblings with them.

'Additional Contacts' should be people in Hong Kong who may be called if we cannot reach the primary guardians. These should be alternatives to the guardians' numbers e.g your helper, another family member or friend.
