David's expertise in inquiry-based mathematics, the PYP framework, and the use of manipulatives provided our teachers with powerful, research-based strategies to enhance our teaching and learning immediately.

Our staff have also been busy enhancing their skills, attending various workshops during the recent ESF CPD Day on topics including Universal Design for Learning, Al's impact, and brain development.

Our classrooms are very busy as usual! Year 2 students are building a strong foundation in numeracy by making and ordering 3-digit numbers. They also demonstrated fantastic teamwork by designing an outfit for a teammate using only newspaper. Year 5 students kicked off their unit by exploring 3D model-making, brilliantly recreating organisms using newspaper and tape. Their next step is to paint and add intricate details to bring their models to life.


