# TAI PO FUNDRAISING DETAILS

- Step 1: Open your mobile banking app and select 'Make an FPS transfer.'
- Step 2: Select 'Scan to pay". This will open your phone's camera. Hold your device over the payee's QR code.
- Step 3: Enter your 6-digit Mobile Banking PIN, Mobile Security Key password or user biometric authentication to verify your identity and proceed with payment.
- Step 4: Ensure that the payee is listed as "English Schools Foundation" then enter your desired donation amount.

Step 5: If the payee's name and the transaction details are correct, select 'Confirm' to complete the transaction.
